

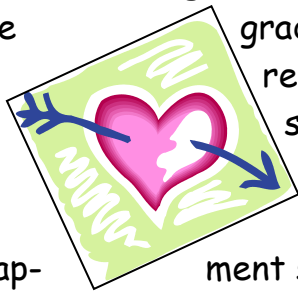


Second Graders Are Spectacular

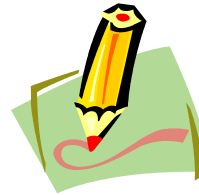

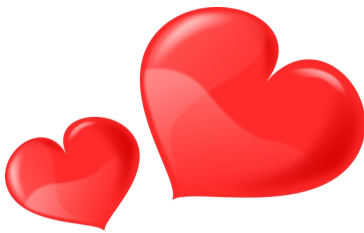

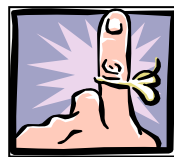
